### (B) Native-speaking English Teacher (NET) Scheme, EDB

Our school's **NET** helps develop students' interest in learning English by providing an authentic, language-rich environment for them.



Currently, the **Primary Literacy Programme – Reading** (**PLP-R**) is implemented in P2 and P3, in order to enhance the reading proficiency of our junior primary students.



Beginning with P1 in the 2023/24 school year, we will gradually replace our school's PLP-R programme, by adopting an enhanced and updated programme called the **Space Town Literacy Programme**. It includes additional aspects such as: **e-learning**, **self-directed learning**, early introduction to **guided reading**, **phonics strategies**, and **self-evaluation tools** for schools.



## (C) Diversified Learning Opportunities

With the purpose of fostering students to learn by experiences, broaden their horizon and raise up their sense of achievement, our school provides diverse English learning opportunities to students to demonstrate their talents through multiple learning and life-wide learning activities. Student activities range from Enrichment Programmes, English Ambassadors to assorted internal and external competitions.

In a lively morning, the participants were able to apply what they had learnt from textbooks with hands-on experience to make an Italian pizza in an authentic setting.








I like her very much. I hope we can be best friends forever. We have a lot in common. She is an important person to me.
